Ancient Egypt: Daily Life

What did they wear? (Clothes and Accessories)

Egyptians were clean and looking nice was very important for them. Most people, men and women, wore jewellery. The rich wore jewellery made of gold and silver, while the poorer people used copper. For clothes, rich people wore white linen clothes but slaves couldn't, they used patterned fabrics.

Makeup was important as well for men and women. They painted their eyes and bodies.

Where did they live? (Housing)

The average family lived in a village of mud houses. The houses were small and they didn't have many windows or furniture. People slept in beds made of ropes and wood.

What did they eat? (Food)

Egyptians ate mainly bread, but they also had fruits, vegetables, lamb, and goats. They cooked in clay ovens and used clay plates. They drank beer.

What occupations did they have? (Occupations)

Egyptian society was complex and they worked in different jobs. They included:

- Farmers: they grew barley, wheat, onion, grapes or cucumbers.
- Craftspeople: there were carpenters, jewellers, potters and leather workers.
- Soldiers: they fought and kept the Pharaohs safe.
- Scribes: they wrote and copied papyrus.
- Priests: they prayed in religious ceremonies.

What did they believe in? (Religion)

Egyptians were polytheists, they believed in Gods and Goddess. For example: Isis, Osiris, Ra, or Nefertiti. They were very superstitious, so they carried amulets: the scarab.

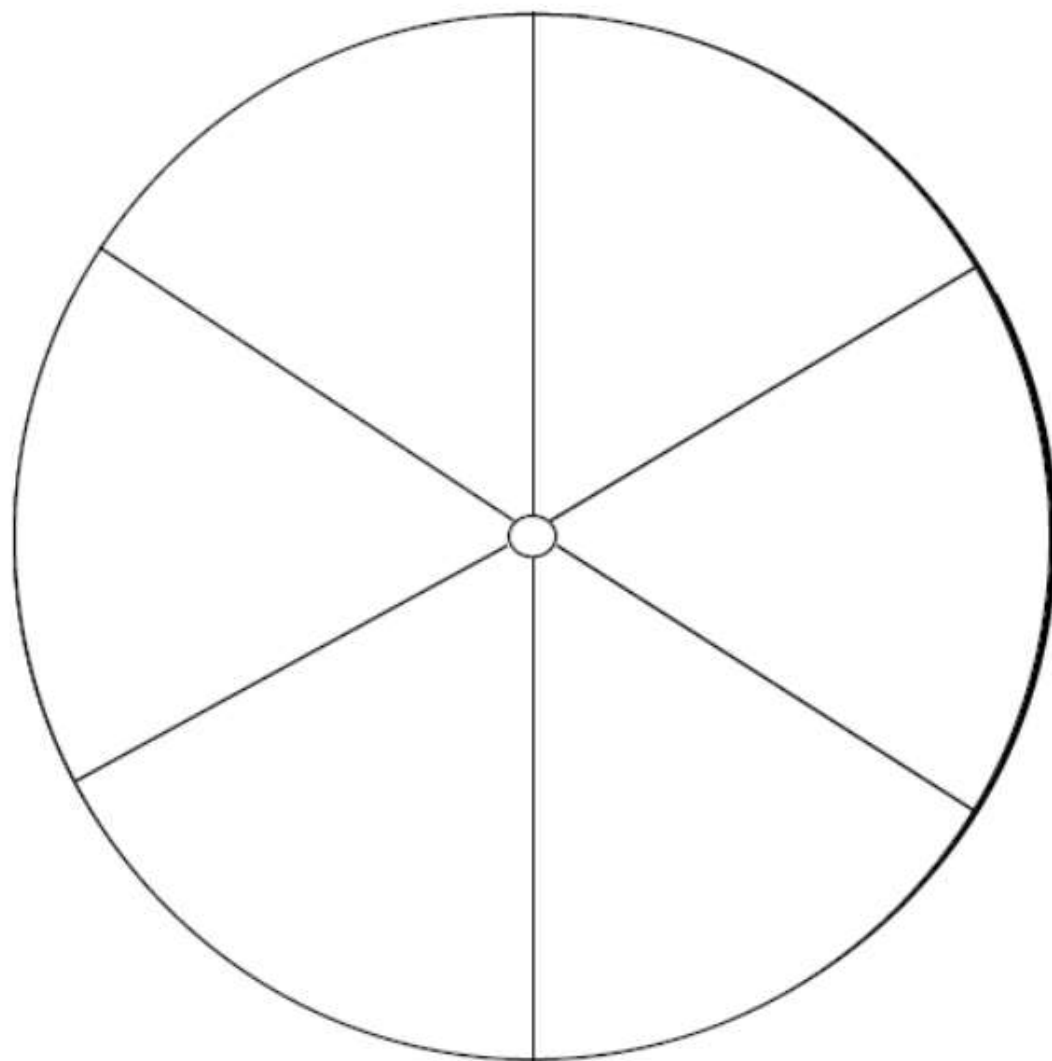

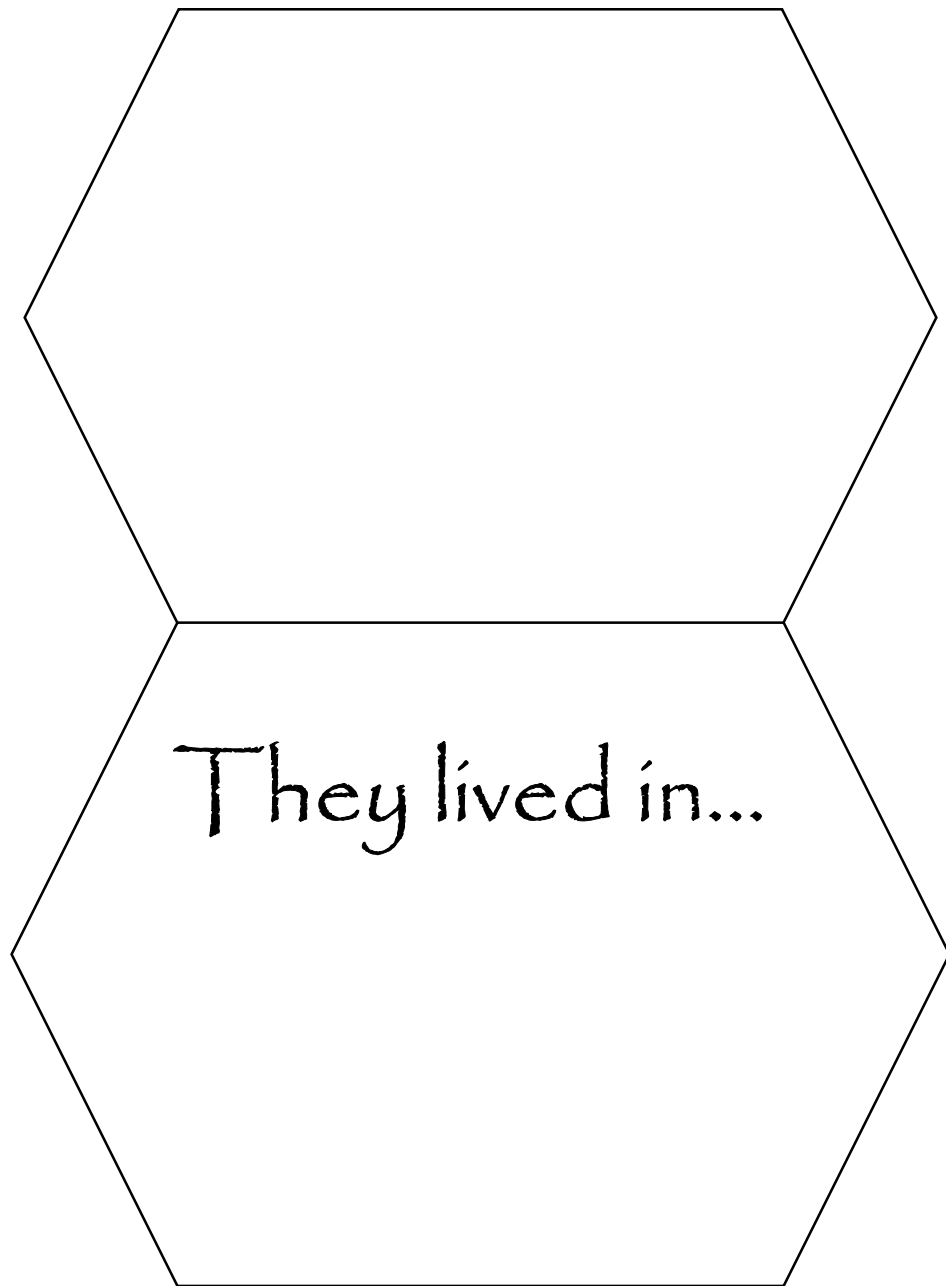
